

The Iowa Department of Human Rights is once again offering the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program through MATURA Action Corporation. This program has been established to help qualified low-income Iowa homeowners and renters pay for a portion of their primary heating costs.

Eligibility for participation is established according to the following federal Household income guidelines:

Household Size	Annual Income	Monthly Income
1	29,160	2430.00
2	39,440	3286.67
3	49,720	4143.33
4	60,000	5000.00
5	70,280	5856.67
6	80,560	6713.33
For Each Additional Member	Add \$10,280	

*This program is not designed to pay a household's total energy costs. It will provide supplemental assistance based on several factors including household income, household size, dwelling type, and type of heating fuel, among others.. Once approved for assistance, a one-time payment will be made to the household's primary fuel vendor. Payments will be credited as funds are made available by the Iowa Department of Human Rights, and all payments are subject to availability of funds.

Energy Saving Tips

Make sure air registers and radiators are clean and unblocked by drapes or furniture.

Check and change your furnace filter regularly

Set back your thermostat, turning it back 10 degrees for hours a day can be an 10% savings on energy costs

Keeping unused rooms closed off with the drapes shut will reduce energy used to heat. Be sure to leave all registers open.

Do not use more lights in a room than needed. Turn lights (and other appliances) off when leaving the room.

Use warm or cold water settings for most loads of laundry. Clothes will still get clean and you could reduce energy use by 50%.

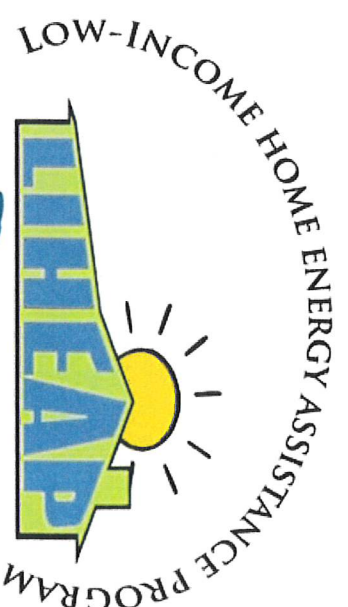
Take more showers than baths. A bath uses 15-25 gallons of hot water, but a 5-minute shower uses less than 10 gallons.



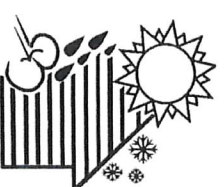

- All other Households can apply beginning November 1, 2023

WHAT TO TAKE WHEN YOU GO TO APPLY: →

- Proof of income for the **past 30 days** or your most recent **income tax return** (2022 or 2023)
 - Recent heat bill
 - Recent electric bill
 - Birthdates of all household members.
 - **PROOF** of Social Security numbers **REQUIRED**
- Acceptable forms of proof include:
- ◊ Social Security Card
 - ◊ Financial statement showing SSN
 - ◊ Payroll stub showing SSN
 - ◊ Military ID showing SSN
 - ◊ Document from Social Security Administration showing SSN
